It is to be Considered that the Scarcity was Gen¹¹ every one had much adoe to provide for themselfs and that wee suppose restrained the Countrys usuall Civillity and Supplyes & that Greater plenty will succeed. yo^r Ex^{cy} may please to Consider that this Province has but very Lately been Received into his Maj^{tyes} Immediate Protection & hithertoe things scarce reduced to or fixed in a Certainty & therefore may be Excused if wee are not soe well provided of a house for a Gov^r as those that from the begining were soe but as wee have formerly Considered others in respect of a house we will give you noe occassion to think you are less in our Esteeme then any predecessor nor
