Journall of the Councill in Assembly folio 49 whereby it was ordeined th^t publique and County ferrymen should keep ordinary without paying for their lycences, and whereas Severall persons have been thereby encouraged to keep fferry's Cheaper expecting the benefitt thereby proposed and designed them we humbly entreat your Ex^{cy} that they may not be deprived thereof.

Sent p Major Thomas Smith, Cap^t Waughop, M^r Tilghman and M^r Campbell who returne to the house and say they delivered their Message.

Then came down the hon^{ble} Col: Robotham and Col: Addison to this house and sygnified that his Ex^{cy} comanded them to attend him at the Councill Chamber.

House adjourned for halfe an hour, to waite on his Ex^{cy}

House Mett. M^r ffrancis Jenkins, M^r John Bozman, M^r Walter Lowe, and M^r Sam^l Collins appear as Delegates for Somerset County M^r Campbell and M^r Lockerman sent to the Councill with them to have them sworne.

House Adjourned till 7 of the clock to morrow Morning.

Tuesday March the 15th 1697/8.

House mett, and called over, Then read over what was done Yesterday as also from the beginning of this assembly. M^r Campbell and M^r Lockerman reporte they saw the Delegates of Somerset County Subscribe the Test. Debated in the house Concerning the piscattaway Indians.

House adjourned till 12 of the clock.

Post meredim, House mett. put to the Question if this house do think it convenient that his Ex^{cy} the Gov^r should make a Warr with the piscattaway Indians or not, and carryed in the negative nemine Contradicente.
