the hon^{ble} Council in Barbadoes dated the 28th of
Aprill last past Relating to the News in those
parts &^{ca} Ordered that the Same be Copied
out and Sent to the respective Counties of the
Province to be made Publick; w^{ch} followes in
these words Viz^t Vpon the 17th Instant Adm^l
Nevill with 20: odd of his Ma^{ty} Ships of Warr and ffire Ships
Arrived here and this day set Sail in quest of the ffrench
Squadron under the Com^{and} of Mons^r Pontie whom we hope
they will over take and destroy they toucht not at any of these
Islands but went directly to Petty Guavers having Some
Design upon Hispaniola or the Spanish Galloones. I think
it necessary to acquaint you that by an Ord^r from Whitehall
the men of Warr are forbidden to Press and the Power is now
lodged in myself and Council, which shall be improved, for
the Encouragem^t and Content of the Traders.
