Mr Charles Brebands Pet & Ord^r about Goods Seized . . . A Peticōn of Charles Breband about Goods Lib. II. D. Seized from him by Henry Denton Nav^l Officer of the Port of Annapolis, as being an Alien Merch^t &^{ca} Setting forth that he had been Naturalized in England but forgot to bring any Certificate thereof with him, therefore prayed time to send for England about it, and that in the Interim the s^d Seizure might be taken off

Ordered that the Peticōn^r giving good Security for Answering the Vallue of the Goods seized (if he don't produce his Letters of Naturalizacōn or Denization or Some Authentick prooffe for the Same, within a year and a day from the date hereof) unto George Plater Esq his ma^{ts} Receiver for the Use of his Ma^{ty} &^{ca} that then the prayer of the Peticōn^r be granted.

Mr Jno Chiles Ord^r to Mr Vangazell for a horse M^r John Chiles the Bearer hereof being sent by his Ex^{ncy} S^r Edm^d Andros his Ma^{ts} Lieuten^t and Gov^r Gen^l of Virg^a on an Express to New York for his Ma^{ts} imedeiate Service, It is hereby directed and Ordered that M^r Jacob Vangazeloe do upon his Arrivall in Cœcill County take Care to provide him with a horse as farr as New Castle in Ord^r to his Dispatch.

June the 10th 1697.

The Councill again Sate and were p^rsent as before.

L^{re} from the Gov^r of Virg^a abt 2 Men of War & 7 other Ships Arrived there . . . Produced and Read a Letter by Express sent from his Ex^{ncy} S^r Edmund Andros his ma^{ts} Govern^r of Virg^a Dated the 4th of June Instant Signifying the Arrivall of two of his ma^{ts} ffrigotts and Seven p. 513 other Ships from England.

Lords of the Councill for Trade &c: L^{re} abt severalls Read. Read also a letter by his Ex^{ncy} Recd: from the R^t hon^{rb}le the Lords of the Councill for Trade &^{ca} dated the 4th of febr^{ry} last past relating to Sevcralls.

Lords of the Councils L^{re} abt Capt Every & pyrats Read together with a printed Proclamation; Read afterwards a Letter recd: from the R^t hon^{rb}le the Lords of his Ma^{ts} most hon^{rb}le Privy Councill dated the 27th of August past together with a Printed Proclamacōn about one Cap^t Every alias Bridgman and his Seamen &^{ca}
