Victualls and Refreshm<sup>15</sup> (wh<sup>ch</sup> are more plentifull within yo<sup>r</sup> Lib. H. D. Governm<sup>1</sup> and from whence a great part of our Supplies are fetcht unto Newfoundland, as may be Needfull for his Ma<sup>15</sup> Ships and Land fforces imployed on the Expedtion thither, the Success of w<sup>ch</sup> is of great Import to the whole Nation, and these Colonies particularly concern'd therein, and I am Extreamly Sollicitous that it be not disappointed through the failing of Supplies, Vessells for the transporting of which will be Easily procured here; if you stand in Need thereof.
