At our Coming over into Virga from Capt George Masons we gave yor Exney an Accot of our design, knowing yor Exney had our Orders sent by our Maryland Post. We have been up with the Emperor of Piscattoway at his ffort beyond the ffirst mountain; who Calling his Great men together readily Complyed to our proposalls, being willing to Return into Maryland again making Satisfaction for the Negro, tho still denyes the murther and that they give this Satisfaction rather than have any difference, which we humbly Signifye to yor Exney & Remain

Yor Exncys Humble Servants
