Requiring assistance of men ships and Provisions from that Governmt in Ordr to the Recovery of the Island of Newfoundland and the Reestablishm' of his Ma" Subjects in that Trade and ffishery in which they have been lately disturbed by the ffrench &ca) Signifying the very great impoverishmt of his Mats Subjects in those parts through means of the Warr and the ffailing of the two last years Crops; whereby they are incapacitated to Comply with his mats Royall Comands the Expectacons therein by which he does desire of his Exncy and this Governm' some Encouragem' may be Given for sending such Provisions Vituals and Refreshm¹⁵ unto Newfoundland as may be Needfull for his Mats Ships and Land
