At the Port of Annapolis, Octo. 8th 1696.

Then rēcd: from Maj^r Edward Dorsey these following
Armes &ca together with an Ord^r of Councill, Dated the 30th
of Septemb. last past directing that none of the s^d things
should be made use off, unless in Case of invasion or insur-
rection, which God fforbid.

ditto, Crabine bullets, 2: Ditto pistoll bullets & 3460: fflints,
each of us Seperately of all the foregoing things a peice, to and
for the Vse of the Counties to which we belong, as Witness
our hands the day & year aboves^d.
