At the Port of Annapolis, Octo. the 8<sup>th</sup> 1696.

Then Recd: from Maj<sup>r</sup> Edward Dorsey these following armes &<sup>ca</sup> together with an Ord<sup>r</sup> of Councill Dated the 30<sup>th</sup> of Septemb<sup>r</sup> last past, directing that none of the s<sup>d</sup> things should be made Vse off, Unless in case of invasion or insurrection which God fforbid.

One hand mortar, 2: Granado pouches, 20: Granado Shells, Sixty ffusees, Seven Cases of pistolls, Seven Carabins & belts, ffive Cartouch boxes & belts, ffive Byonets and belts, two pick Axes, Two Mattocks, ffour wheel barrow Irons, ffour Steele Spades, ffour Shovells, two barrells of Musket bullets,
