believed he will be Necessitated to Conclude a Peace (wch God Lib. H. D. grant may be) for the honour of our King and the generall Good of Christendome.

You may be Sure your Express should not want my Protection coming on such Emergency but her luckey Arrivall here for the best and most satisfactory Accot of Affairs I possibly could give you as I have here done causeth her dispatch hence this day to you, so that she could need no ffriendship of mine, w^{ch} I should readily afford her or any other Service in my Power for the Safety and preservation of any of his Mats Colony's being Sr
