and ffinish'd and Examine the Records and papers by the
fformer list thereof taken, to see if none are wanting, and
Make Return thereof unto his Ex^{ncy} the Govern^r with all possi-
ble Speed, And that M^r Gouldsborough be Assistant to them
therein.

Ordered that Kenelm Cheseldyn p^rsent Commissary and
M^r John Bouije his Clerk be henceforth dismist from Execu-
