and ag<sup>t</sup> M<sup>r</sup> John LLewellin for not Compleating and ffinishing  
the Records of that Office, during his Officiateing as Clerk  
there, and that they be proceeded against according to the  
Utmost Rigour of the Law It appearing by a list of the s<sup>d</sup>  
Commissary's Records this day produced in Councill that the  
s<sup>d</sup> LLewellin has only Recorded Seventeen Inventories, And  
as to the Neglect of the p<sup>r</sup>sent Commissary, it appears by his  
taking out an Action ag<sup>t</sup> the s<sup>d</sup> Lewellin in the Prov<sup>l</sup> Court of  
this Province, for Causing him to Compleat his Records as  
afores<sup>d</sup> but leting the s<sup>d</sup> Action ffall without a ffinal End  
made, whereby the Records of that time are Still left Imper-  
fect to the very great prejudice and Damage of all persons  
Concern'd.

Ordered that the Kings Lawyers prepare Writts to Issue to P. 541  
the Justices of the Respective County's to Certifye unto his  
Ex<sup>ncy</sup> what Testamentary proceedings have been Return'd  
into the Commissary's Office, Since the late happy Revolution  
and what are still left behind and that a full Return of all be  
made upon Oath by the Officers that have the Custody of the  
Same, and Certifyed accordingly unto his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> with all  
possible Speed.

M<sup>r</sup> Attorney Gen<sup>l</sup> and M<sup>r</sup> Robert Gouldsborough his Ma<sup>ty</sup>  
Counsell at Law being p<sup>r</sup>sent. His Ex<sup>ncy</sup> is pleased to give  
Charge that they take Care, to see all his Ma<sup>ty</sup> Business  
depending in any of the Courts of this Province Speedily  
Completed & Ended.

Ordered that M<sup>r</sup> Robert Mason high Sherriff of S<sup>t</sup> Marries  
County and M<sup>r</sup> Sam<sup>l</sup> Watkins Navall Officer of Petuxant  
District do upon Sight hereof go to M<sup>r</sup> Cœcilus Butler and  
make Demand of what Certificates, relating to discharge of  
Navigacōn Bonds he has in his Custody it being Signified  
that he had ffound Severall in Mattapany House, The s<sup>d</sup> M<sup>r</sup>  
Butler being hereby Ordered to deliver the Same unto M<sup>r</sup>  
Sam<sup>l</sup> Wattkins afores<sup>d</sup> who is to give Receipt for what he  
Receives and make a list of the Same, and make Return  
thereof, to his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> at the Port of Annapolis with all Con-  
venient Speed, and it is hereby further Ordered that the s<sup>d</sup>  
Sherriff Sumons the s<sup>d</sup> M<sup>r</sup> Butler so that he be and appear  
before his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> in Councill at the next prov<sup>l</sup> Court to make  
Oath to the said list of Certificates &<sup>ca</sup>
