

Lib. H. D. Ordered that (pursuant to the advice of the Iustices & Grand Iury of the Provincial Court, the Com̄ittee for laying the publick leavy and the Gentlemen that went upon the Indian treaty) a former Ord<sup>r</sup> passed last Assembly appointing severall persons to treat w<sup>th</sup> the Indians at the head of the Bay, be putt in execution by the s<sup>d</sup> p<sup>r</sup>sons or the Major part of them, and that they take such p<sup>r</sup>son or persons to be their Interpreter or Interpreters (by them to be sworne accordingly) as they shall think fitt. And it is hereby further Ordered that the Gentlemen that go out of Cæcill County acquaint the Shevanor Indians how that his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> never rec<sup>d</sup> those presents said to be sent by Coll<sup>o</sup> Herman.

Vpon Representation & during this noise of Indians, Ordered that no Masters of any Shipps or Vessells trading to this Province presume to export or carry away any of the Inhabitants thereof w<sup>th</sup>out particular leave and lycense first had & obtained for the same.

Ordered that the thirteen men & two Officers this day agreed upon to be raised for the strengthening the Garrison & ffrontiers upon Potomock be forthwith raised accordingly and sent up to be appointed their Stations by the Hono<sup>ble</sup> Coll. John Addison of Prince Georges County; the w<sup>ch</sup> said men are to be raised as follows viz<sup>t</sup> Four out of Annarrund<sup>ll</sup> County, three out of Calvert, three out of S<sup>t</sup> Maries, and three out of Charles Counties. And that Richard Owen of Ann arrundell County be Captain to Com̄and part of the said men, and Giles Hill of S<sup>t</sup> Maries County Lieuten<sup>t</sup> to Com̄and another part thereof. hereby directing and Ordering that the Colonels of the said Counties take care to gett the said men raised w<sup>th</sup> all imaginable expedition, to be imprest for the said service w<sup>th</sup> their horses; but if Volunteers can be procured afterwards that then they be taken; and if wanting of armes & horses of their own that they be furnisht & equipt out of the Countrey armes & have horses also imprest, w<sup>th</sup> a suitable quantity of powder & ball; hereby signifying th<sup>t</sup> the said men will be allowed & paid out of the Publick for such their service perform'd for the Countrey.

Ordered that (pursuant to the advice of the Hono<sup>rd</sup> the Justices and Grand Iury of the Provincial Court together w<sup>th</sup> the other Gentlemen called to be consulted about Indian affairs) the Colonel of each respective County do imediately upon sight hereof raise & choose out of the Militia under their respective Com̄ands (or any other persons not inlisted) the following men, in Order to the strengthening the ffrontiers of this Province in manner following; Viz<sup>t</sup> That Ann arrundell County do raise forty five men, Calvert County forty, Prince Georges County twenty, Baltimore County fifteen, S<sup>t</sup>
