Ordered that (according to the opinion of the Kings Lawyers this day read at the Board) the Sherriff of Som'sett County do upon sight hereof take care to sumons the Reverend M<sup>r</sup> Iames Brechin, M<sup>r</sup> Sam<sup>II</sup> Davies and M<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Denice Master of the Mary (persons said to be present & assenting to a certain pretended Marriage betwixt M<sup>r</sup> George Layfield and M<sup>rs</sup> Priscilla White of the said County) to be and appear before his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> in Councill the last Tuesday in ffeb<sup>ry</sup> next to answer the prœmises, whereof they are in no wise to faile at their perill.

Produced & read a Letter by his Exney recd from Mr Edwd Green his Maj<sup>tys</sup> Surveyor of Lands in Som<sup>r</sup>sett County; Signifying that his occasions call him much abroad, and that he is providing to remove himselfe to the Port of Annapolis to follow the brewing Trade So that he cannot attend the duty of his said office, therefore desires to be dismist therefrom and some other Person appointed. Ordered that the same be referred to Mr ffrancis Jenckins and Mr John West of the said County to recommend some other fitt and capable person to be constituted in his stead.
