June the 3^d 1697. Then Rec^d of Henry Denton Clk: of the Councill 20 ffusees being delivered by Order of his Ex^{ncy} & Councill this day I say Rec^d Rich Brightwell.

He had delivered to him at his Ex^{ncys} House two Spades two Shovells & one Pickax pursueant to the Ord^r of the 3^d of June as above.

Acco of Armes delivrd to Capt Olton by: H: Denton

At the Port of Annapolis June the 23^d 1697. Deli^d pursuant to Ord^r at the Port of Annapolis unto Cap^t In^o Ouldton & his men, Three Grannad Shells fourteen fussees fifty nine flints forty three pounds of Bullets one Pick ax Spades & Shovells they had none the above were delivered by me.

Memorand^m There was also 32 Fuzees sent by the Express that went to Coll^o Addison^s, who was ordered to deliver them to M^r Greenfeild in order to have them sent to the Hono^{ble} Coll^o John Courts, for the use of Charles County, but were by mistake carryed and delivered unto Collonⁿ Addison aforementioned.

Ammunition Delivd to Capt Red Brightwell by Hen^r Denton

Delivered to Captⁿ Rich^d Brightwell by Ord^r of the Hon^{oble} S^r Thom^s Laurence in the absence of his Ex^{ncy} fifteen pounds weight of bullets 24 Muskett flints 24 Carbine flints & 45 Pistoll flints
