The Condiçõn of the above Obligation is such that if the abovebound John Salter, his Heires Exe<sup>rs</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> or assignes or any of them doe withall convenient speed performe fulfill observe & keep all and every the covenants articles & agreements entred into heretofore by the s<sup>d</sup> John Salter with the Iustices of Talbott County concerning the Court house of the same County, at the first coming of the said John Salter to the said Court house and if the said In<sup>o</sup> Salter doe pay back
