Know all men by these presents that I George Muschamp of S^t Maryes County Esq^r Thom^s Tench of Ann Arrundell County Esq^r and Phillip Clarke of S^t Maryes County Gent. do owe and stand indebted unto our Sovereigne Lord King William the third &^{ca} in the full & just sum of five hundred pounds Sterling money of England. The w^{ch} paym^t well and truly to be made to our Sovereigne Lord the King his heires & Success^{rs} we bind our selves & each of us our & every of our heires Execu^{rs} & adm^{rs} joyntly & severally firmly by these presents, As witness our hands & Seales this 12th day of Octob^r in the ninth year of his said Maj^{tes} Reigne &^{ca} Annoq Domini: 1697:

The Condiçō of the above obligacōn is such that whereas the above bound Geo: Muschamp Esq^r hath this day by his application & motion in Councill signified unto his Ex^{ncy} Fran^s Nicholson Esq^r Cap^t Gener^{ll} and Govern^r in chief of his Maj^{tes} said Province of Maryland, that his Maj^{ty} having as yet appointed no receiver for the district of Pocomoke he is willing to take upon him that charge and care, by reason it was joynd to that of Pocomoke district, in the time of the late Collon^{ll} Nehem^{ha} Blakiston whereof he the s^d Muschamp is by his Majestyes Comission actually constituted receiver & fforasmuch as an order of his Ex^{ncy} & Councill hath accordingly passed the day & year above written appointing the said George Muschamp Esq^r Receiver of his Maj^{tes} Revenue of Pocomoke district afores^d in as full & ample power as by his Comission & instructions for Pocomoke district he is authorized & impowered, Recourse whereunto being had may more fully & at large appear. Now if the said Geo: Muschamp shall & doe in all things well & faithfully discharge & pform th^t trust by the said ord^r reposed in him as also produce & render before his Ex^{ncy} in Councill a true & perfect acc^o (twice every Year) of all Sum & Sum^s of money or tob^o as shall by him be collected for the use of his Maj^{ty} within the district or precinct aforesaid from time to time accordingly make oath to the same dureing his acting in that station then this present obligation to be void & of none Effect, otherwise to Stand & remain in full force power & virtue.
