a fuller Councill and Ordered in the interim to be Recorded. Lib. H. D. Produced also at the same time Instructions to his said Ex^{ncy} (with certain specimens annext) for the due observance of the severall Acts of Trade & Navigation, pursuant to the aforemention'd Oath, Signed by their Ex^{ncys} the Lords Iustices of England, and Countersign'd by the R^{tt} Hono^{ble} the Lords of the Treasury by their Ex^{ncyes} Comand, w^{ch} were likewise deferred the Reading till a fuller Councill, whereat the Severall Collectors & Navall Officers on this side the Bay are summoned to be present.

Then read a direction from the R^{tt} Hono^{ble} the Comiss^{rs} for p. 616 executing the Office of Lord High Admirall of England, Ireland &^{ca} Dated 29th of Aprill last past Empowering his Ex^{ncy} ffrancis Nicholson Esq^r to grant Commissions to S^r Thomas Laurence Baron^t to be Iudge, Henry Denton Register, and Thomas Collyer Marshall of his Maj^{tes} Court of Vice Admir-

alty for the Province of Maryland.

The Honoble Sr Thomas Laurence Baront signifying his indisposition of body & his being otherwise taken up wth his Secretaries imploy does humbly desire to be excused from being put in any such Commission and prayes his Exney would be pleased to conferr the same upon such other person as in his wisdome he shall think fitt.

Then read a Commission under the Seale of the Admiralty of England bearing date the 26th day of Iune 1697. Empowering his Ex^{ncy} the Govern of Maryland to appoint Iudges, Registers, Marshalls and Advocates of the Courts of Admiralty of

Maryland, Pensilvania & West Jersey weh was read.

Afterwards produced by the aforenamed Esq^r Randolph two Commissions under the Seale of the Admiralty in England bearing date the 26th day of Iune 1697. The one constituting M^r Will^m Rodeney to be Reg^r and the other M^r Robt Webb to be Marshall of his Maj^{tes} Court of Vice Admiralty in the Province of Pensilvania and the three lower Counties & West Iersey. The s^d Esq^r Randolph signifying that Coll Quarry had a Commission for being Iudge of the said Court, and that M^r Edw^d Chilton had a Comission for being Advocate of the s^d Court, as also of his Maj^{tes} Court of Vice Admiralty in Maryland.
