We Send you herewith all his Majestys Proclamacon of the 28th of the Last month prohibiteing his Subjects to enter into the Service of forreigne Princes or States that you may Cause it to be published in the usual Places within his Majesties Territorys under your Governt and as much as in you lies take Care that his Majesties Pleasure therein Exprest be duly Observed and the Transgressors thereof punished so we bid you heartily Farewell
