them in this Province

Ordered that the Sheriff of each County shew the said
Proclamation to the Ministers of the several Parishes within
their County & give them Copies thereof & where there is
no minister to the chief Vestryman

M^r Iohn Broadhurst of Calvert County appearing at the
Board is asked if he was not in Company with M^r Thomas
Johnson & Captain Richard Smith when Johnson said that all
the people were Rogues to the Gov^t M^r Broadhurst says he
was in M^r Johnsons Comp^a & Cap^t Smiths Comp^a

The said M^r Broadhurst is ordered to draw up his Deposi-
tion in writing

M^r Notley Rozier of Charles County appearing his Excel-
lency tells him he has been informed that he has been very
often in M^r Sly's Company therefore requires him to give his
Deposition what he hath heard the said Sly M^r Cood or others
their Associates say in relation to this his Majestys Gov^t or
himself the Governor thereof

The said M^r Rozier saith that he hath been often in M^r Sly's
Company and will give his Deposition of what he heard

Produced & read a Letter from Lieu^t Col^l Low with a
warrant to take M^r Robert Mason upon which he made Re-
turn that he had taken the said Mason who Languished &
said that he was not in any Condition to be brought up to
this Port of Annapolis without Endangering his Life

Wherefore inasmuch as the said M^r Rob^t Mason is now p. 88
under arrest of the said Sheriff hath so far prevailed with him
to returne him Languishing in prison Pretending such his
disability of Body to be brought up hither but forasmuch as
he hath often Counterfeited & dealt hypocritically upon this
