Iohn Young appearing at the Board says that being Com-
manded by Lieu^t Col^o Low to apprehend & secure M^r Robert
Mason the said Masons wife took a drawn Sword in her hand

Whereupon ordered that the Sheriff of Ann Arundel County
take the said Elizabeth Wilson into his Custody & have her
without Delay before his Excellency the Gov^r to Answer such
her Contempt
