M' Mason is told that his Excellency has recd a Complaint against him made by Mrs Mary Denton Wido & relict of Mr Henry Denton late Clerk of the Council dec'd for that he the said Mason had sold her late husband in his Life time one Negro man slave a white Woman & Mulatto Child which said Child by the Law of this Province then was & now is a Servant belonging to the Ministry of King William & Queen Mary parish in S<sup>t</sup> Marys County until it should arrive at the Age of thirty one years & that she the said Mrs Denton was threatned by the principal Vestryman of that Parish to be Sued for the same

His Excellency is pleased to ask Mr Mason if he is not & was not a Vestry man of that parish when he sold the said Negro, white woman & mulatto Child who says he was & is one of that Vestry
