Know Yee that whereas his Ma^{ty} by his Royall Order in Councill bearing Date the 23rd day of febr^{ry} Anno Domini 1692, has been pleased thereby to Command that the Lord Baltmore Should be permitted (without any disturbance or interruption) to Collect and Receive, by such p^rson or p^rsons as he should thereunto Authorize & Appoint Severall Sum^s of money and Tob^o accruing to his s^d Lordship (within this his s^d Majesties Province) as Proprietor of the Same; And fforasmuch as it hath been made appear unto me by Henry Darnall Gentl. (the Bearer hereof) how that he is here legally Authorized by his s^d Lordship for looking after & managing all his Concerns and Receiving his Rents & Dues &^{ca} And withall hath Signified his intentions of going for England this ffeet in Ordr^t to Settle & make up his Acco^{ts} with his Lordship there desiring Some Certificate thereof from this Governm^t whereby he might not be Retarded in his passage thither. These are therefore to Certifye that due Satisfaction hath been here given by the Bearer (as above) concerning the p^rmises, who is hereby permitted to Ship himself on Board and depart this Province accordingly without any molestacōn or hindrance whatsoever, provided he hath fully complied with the Law of this Countrey in Such Case; desiring all his Ma^{ty}s Loving Subjects to whom this shall Come to Suffer the s^d Henry Darnall to pass unto his s^d Lordship without any interruption to the End and purpose intended; In testimony whereof I have Caused the Broad Seal of this his Ma^{ty}s Province to be hereunto Affixed this 17 day of March in the Ninth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord King William the Third &^{ca} Annoq Domini 1696/7.
