Then was read over what was done yesterday. Maj Tho: Hamond appeared and ord^d by M^r Speaker that Maj^r Dorsey and M^r W^m Parker attend M^r Hamond to see him sworne before his Ex^{cy}.

They ret. and say they saw him sworne.

Doct^r Iacob Loockerman made his appearance in the house.

The house attended his Ex^{cy} and Council upon the Conference where having some debate they againe returned.

Putt to the Question and Gen^{ly} resolved by the house that they concurr with the reporte of the Comittee for Stateing the Case of the Laws of Maryland.

Resolved that twenty one members with the Speaker make the house.
