Ordered that M<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Harris M<sup>r</sup> Phil<sup>o</sup> Loyd, M<sup>r</sup> Geo. Muschamp and Coll Tho<sup>s</sup> Ennalls be added to the Committee of Laws and being joined into one Committee they are to enquire into the charge of Itinerant Justices and compute whether such Judges will be more charge to the Countrey then the present constitucōn and likewise the advantage and disadvantage that may accrue to the province thereby, and to make report thereof to the house.

M<sup>r</sup> John Salter, M<sup>r</sup> Sam<sup>l</sup> Young and Cap<sup>t</sup> John Dorsey appointed a Com<sup>ee</sup> to enquire into the repaires of the house bought of Maj<sup>r</sup> Edw<sup>d</sup> Dorsey for a Store house to Lodge the publick armes and Likewise to make reporte of the estimate of such repaires and are empowered to treat and agree with any pson that will undertake the repaires of the said house. They are sent out and Ordered to make Speedy report thereof to this house

And ordered that Message be sent to his Ex<sup>cy</sup> to Interpose his authority that M<sup>r</sup> White menconed in the petition may be paid the 40 p poll to some equivoilent satisfaction for the time of his Service in the Upper parte of King and Queens pish in Charles County and that his Ex<sup>cy</sup> would be pleased to compell the Vestery of the said pish to render an acc<sup>t</sup> of the 40 p poll to his Ex<sup>cy</sup> or to some pson as his Ex<sup>cy</sup> shall please to Substitute for that purpose, which message is as follows, viz<sup>t</sup>
