By the house of Delegates March 24th 1701/2

May it please Your Ex^{cy}

We doe againe acknowledge your Ex^{cy} wise and just conduct and Government and the care you have taken to lessen the charge & Expences of this province which wee are sensibly affected with and as a gratefull recognicōn thereof we desire your Ex^{cy} to accept of fflower hundred pounds Str: to be paid out of the first money that cann be raized after those burthens that are upon us.

Ordered that M^r Sam^l Young and M^r Mathias Vanderhayden goe up to his Ex^{cy} and Councill to see them sworne.
