

P. R. O. And therefore you shall not reenact any law, w^{ch} hath, shall, or haue been once Enacted there, Except upon very urgent occasions, but in noe case more than once without our Express consent

9: And you are particularly not to pass any Law or doe any act, by Settlement, Grant or otherwise, whereby our revenue may be lessened or impaired, without our Especiall leave or Commands therein

10. You shall not pmitt any act or order to pass in our said Province, whereby the price or vallue of our currant Coyne (whether it be forreigne, or belonging to our Dominions) wthin yo^r Governem^t may be altered without our p^ticular leaue or direction for the Same

P. 15 11. You shall take care that all planters and Christian servants be well and fittly provided with arms, and th^t they be listed under good officers, and when and as often as shall be thought fitt mustered and trained, whereby they may be in a better readiness for the Defence of our said Province under yo^r government, and you are to use yo^r uttmost, Endeavours, that such planters to each of th^m keep such a number of white Servants, as by Law is directed, and th^t they appeare in Armes att all such tymes as they shall be required.

12: and whereas there is noe power given you by yo^r Comⁿ to Execute Martiall Law in tyme of peace, upon Soldiers in Pay, and that nevertheless itt may be necessary, th^t some care be taken for the keeping of good discipline amongst those, that wee may att any tyme think fitt to send (which may properly be provided for by the Legislatiue power of the same) you are therefore to recommend unto the generall assembly of our said Province that (if not already done) they prepare such act or Law, for the punishm^t of Mutiny and Desertion and false Musters, and for the better preserueing the good Discipline, amongst the said Soldiers as may best answer those Ends

13 You are to demand an account of all persons concerned of Arms, Ammunition and Stores sent to our Said Province from the office of ordinance here, as likewise what other Arms, Ammunition and Stores haue been bought with the publick money for the Service of our said Province, and how the same haue been Employed, and whether any of them, & how many of them haue been sold, spent, lost, decayed or otherwise disposed off, and to whome, & to w^t uses and to transmitt the s^d account as aforesaid

14. You shall take an Inventory of all armes, Ammunition and Stores, remaineing in any of our Magazin's or Garrisons in our said Province, and transmitt the same imēdiately to us
