has done for this province and alsoe for that Excell<sup>t</sup> Sermon  
he was Pleased to give us Yesterday

Resolved that this house meet in the morning at Seaven  
and Sitt till tenn then rise to goe to Prayers and Sitt againe  
from two till Six in the Evening

M<sup>r</sup> William Parker and M<sup>r</sup> Phillimon lloyd come into the  
house and take their places

ment of money in this province w<sup>ch</sup> is referred to y<sup>e</sup> considera-  
tion of the whole house

and delivered the members of this house that they may take  
further consideration thereupon
