Agreed that the Library be placed in the ffree schoole in the roome pitched upon untill such time as it can be otherwise Disposed of without any rent or consideration therefore.

The Peticōn of W Barton being read here and for as much as the same have allready been here considerd and debated this house will not reasume the same therefore rejected

Orderd that Doctor Bray be returned thanks from this house for his Exct Sermon of that text Remember thy Creator in the days of thy youth and Acquainte him that this house desires the same may be printed

Orderd that Coll<sup>l</sup> Loyd Doctor Loockerman Maj<sup>r</sup> Walter Smith and M<sup>r</sup> John Wight goe to Doctor Bray with that Verball message

John Mitchells Peticōn read

It being for an Alloweance for attending as doore keeper to the honorable Councill

The Consideration whereof is referred to the laying the next Publick Leavy

Coll<sup>l</sup> Loyd and others Orderd to attend Doctor Bray returne and say they have delivered their message & that Doctor Bray returnes thanks to the house for their favours.

Proposed by a Member of this House whether it be not reasonable that the Act for Religion and address to his Maj<sup>ty</sup> be comitted to the Care of Doctor Bray to be sent for England to which this house unanimously concurred and Ordered Message to be prepared and Sent for that purpose which follows in these words viz<sup>t</sup>

Proposed by a Member of this house whether it be not reasonable a Cobby of the Act for religion and Address to his Maj<sup>ty</sup> be comitted to the care of Doc<sup>r</sup> Bray to be sent for England.
