Read the petition of Mr Thomas Collier late riding Surv' at Will^m Stad^t appointed by his late Excellency Col^o Nicholson Setting forth that the said Governor Nicholson had Ordered George Plater Esq^r her Majestys Receiver of Puttuxent district to pay him thirty pounds for his Sallary in Officiating that Employment Mr Plater being Demanded why he had not complied with that Order says he has not had of her Majestys in his hands to satisfy his own Sallary for which the Revenue is in Arrears
