In Case the Witness cannot be understood without an Interpreter you are to Choose one whom you are to give an Oath to after this Manner you shall swear according to the best of your skill truly to Interprett between the Witnesses & the Comissioners so help you God & when you use an Interpreter he must put his name to the bottom of the Deposition also with these words p Interpretationem D. E.

You are to observe that the Com¹⁵ may ask the Witnesses ony other Questions than are Contained in the Interrogatorys annexed to the Comission & require the Witness to answer thereto but then the Same must be putt into Writing & sent up with the Dep^o for you are requir'd by the Comission to send up with the Dep^o true Copys of the Interrogatorys upon which they have been Examind & this must be done in Every Shipp.
