

And it being considered that the Provinciaall Court stands Lib. W. B. adjourned unto the second Tuesday of Aprill next. Advised & resolved th^t the s^d Writts of Election be returnable on Tuesday 26th day of April next His Excellency observing th^t his most Sacred Mat^y by his Ord^r in Council at the Court of S^t James the first of October 1714 had been Pleas'd to Direct several Alterations to be made in the Prayers for the Royal Family and further by his Order in Council of the first of August last was pleas'd to Order th^t in the s^d prayers instead of his Royal Highness the Prince there be inserted his Royal Highness George Prince of Wales & th^t necessary Directions shou'd be given accordingly Asks the Advice of the Board if it was not necessary A Proclamation should be issued therefore.

Whereupon Resolved th^t his Excell^{cy} Issue his Proclamation enjoying the same. And the following Proclamation being prepared & read Viz.

A Proclamation

Whereas his most Sacred Mat^y by his Order in Council held at the Court of S^t James's the first of October Seaventeen hundred and fourteen reciting th^t whereas by an Ord^r in Council of the first of August last Sevth Alterations had been directed to be made in the Prayers for the Royal Family was further Graciously pleas'd to order th^t instead of his Royal Highness the Prince in the Prayers and Suffrages for the Royal Family therebe inserted his Royal Highness George Prince of Wales & th^t necessary Directions be given accordingly. I have therefore wth the Advice of his Mat^{ys} honb^{le} Council thought fit by this my Proclamation to notify the same & Strictly to require the Rever^d the Clergie within this province to take due notice thereof & Conforme themselves to his Mat^{ys} s^d order by using the alterations therein directed. Given at the City of Annapolis the 18th day of Jan^{ry} in the first year of the Reigne of Our Sovereigne Lord George by the Grace of God of Great Britain France & Ireland King Defd^r of the Faith &c. Annoq Dni 1714.
