But for certain Causes & Considerations us thereunto especially moving We do think fit to defer Put off and Prorogue the sitting of the said Assembly untill the twenty fourth day of this Instant April and the same is hereby Prorogued Accordingly, Whereof You and every of You are to take due Notice, and no wayes to faile meeting at this Place on the said twenty fourth day of April afores^d Given under Our Broad Seale of Our said Province this twenty first day of Aprill 1716 in the first Year of Our Dominion over the sd Province of Maryland Witness Our Trusty and well beloved John Hart Esqr Our Capt Genril and Govrn in cheif of Our sa Province of Maryland & the Territories thereto belonging.
