Sworn to before the Governor and Council

Ordered that the several Sheriffs within this Province forthwith cause the several Constables within their Bailiwick to take an account of all the white Taxable men and of all Negroes Men Women and Children in different COLUMNS and return a fair List thereof to this Board by the next Provincial Court.

The Board adjourns till to Morrow Morning Eight a Clock

November 4th 1721
