Whereas this present General Assembly stands prorogued to the third tuesday in Iune next being the 15th day of the same month and whereas there is no Business of moment which Requires their attendance at that time I have therefore

rogue the same to the first of Iuly next and to the Intent that all persons Concern'd may have due Notice thereof I do strictly require and Command the several Sheriffs of this Province to make this my Proclamation publick in their respective Counties in the usual manner as they will Answer the Contrary at their Perill Given at Annapolis the 22^d day of May in the tenth year of the Dominion of the right honble Charles Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon &c Annoq Dni 1725
