Upon Consideration of the Letter from the President of Virginia as also the Hue and Cry under the Great Seal of that Colony (heretofore laid before this Board by his Excellency) p. 173 requesting and desiring the Governor and other Officers and Ministers of Justice within this Province to be Aiding and Assisting by their Authority to apprehend Philip Hammond William Hammond and John Howard Inhabitants of this Province for a Robbery Committed on a certain Richard Thacker in that Colony in Order to bring them to Justice in the said Colony this Board are of Opinion that a Provincial Magistrate (in prosecution of the aforesaid request) cause the said persons therein mentioned to be apprehended

And thereupon it is Advised and Ordered that Philip Lee Esq^r one of the Justices of the Provincial Court issue such Proper Process as to him shall seem meet in Order to Convey the said Felons in the said Hue and Cry mentioned to some one Magistrate of the Colony of Virginia there to be dealt with according to Law
