p. 205 The humble Representation of the Honble Philip Lee Esq<sup>r</sup> To his Excellency Charles Calvert Esq<sup>r</sup> Governor of the Province of Maryland and to the honble Members of his Lordships Council in the said province

The said Philip Lee begs Leave to represent to your Excellency and Honours that he sometime ago Intermarried with Elizabeth Sewall Widow and Relict of Henry Sewall late of Saint Marys County Gent deceased who died in the Communion of the Church of Rome and at his decease left Nicholas Sewall an infant now about the age of seven years his Son and Heir of the Body of the said Elizabeth Sewall

That the said Elizabeth at the time of the aforesaid Inter-marriage with the said Philip Professed the Popish Religion but hath since Embraced the protestant Religion & Continues in the profession thereof

That the said Nicholas Sewall the Infant remained under the Guardianship and direction of the said Elizabeth as his Natural Guardian to the time of the said Philips Inter-marriage
