- 3^d That I allow the Book of Articles of Religion agreed upon by the Arch Bishops and Bishops of both Provinces and the whole Clergy in the Convocation holden at London in the Year of Our Lord God 1562 And that I acknowledge all and Every the Articles therein contained being in Number Nine and Thirty besides the Ratification to be agreeable to the Word of God
