The said motion being taken into Consideration & how faithfully the said M<sup>r</sup> Gouldsborough had discharged his Trust therein for his Majestys Service & that he had never been allowed any Sallary or Gratuity therefor Upon his appli- p. 220  
cation he is dismissed

Whereas M<sup>r</sup> John Cood of S<sup>t</sup> Marys County hath been in Town these two days pretending to surrender himself to Justice but has delayed so to do Neither has he given security to the Sheriff of S<sup>t</sup> Marys County for his appearing & answering to what is objecting against him in the Provincial Court on his Majestys Behalf

Ordered that the Sheriff of Ann Arundel County take the said M<sup>r</sup> John Cood into his custody & bring him before the Iustices of his Majestys Provincial Court to be dealt with according to Law

It being Represented at the Board that Lieu<sup>t</sup> Coll<sup>o</sup> John Bigger had refused to act as a Iustice of the Provincial Court he is not thought worthy of being chief Iustice of Calvert County or serving in any other Commission in this Government

Advised that Maj<sup>r</sup> Walter Smith be appointed chief Judge of Calvert County Court
