Offer to Transmitt his Acc^o upon Oath of all the goods he
hath or shall receive & belonging to Pyrates & his Maty
thinks it fitt that those to whose hands any of the s^d Goods
are come should deliver their Accounts in the Same Manner
not doubting but such as are in Places of Publick Trust will
