By the Council in Assembly Sept. 27th 1704

The Message by M^r Muschamp And M^r Tyler this Afternoone Wee haue observd And thereupon Wee do Acknowledge Wee did resolve the Address to her Maj^{ty} in the Name of the province As Absolutely necessary And Agreed on the reasons therein containd And did really beleive the Gen^l Assembly would Unanimously haue Ioynd in it thinking those
