the Just ballance doth not exceed two hundred pounds of Lib. L. L. Tobacco or Sixteen shillings & eight pence in mony the Plaintiff shall be NonSuited.

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that in all Actions which shall at any time after the end of this Sessions of Assembly be sued or prosecuted in the Provincial Court of this Province and upon tryall it doth appear to the Court that the Iust ballance of the Debt or thing in Demand is under fifteen hundred pounds of Tobacco or six pounds five shill in mony the Plaintiff shall be Nonsuited.

And be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that her p. 79 Majestys high Court of Chancery within this Province shall not hear try Determine or give relief in any Cause Matter or thing wherein the Originall Debt or Damages doth not amount to twelve hundred & one pounds of Tobacco and five

pounds and one penny in mony.

And be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that when any Person or Persons against whom any Judgment or Judgments shall be given in any County Court of this Province shall fly or remove him or themselves out of the County and Jurisdiction of that Court where such Judgment or Judgments shall be given That then and in every such Case the Plaintiff or Plaintiffs in every such Judgment or Judgments for the more easy obtaining the fruit and effect of such Judgment shall and may take the Transcript of the Record of such Judgment under the Seale of the Court where the said Judgment shall be obtain'd and lay the same before the Justices of the County Court where the said Defendant or Defendants shall happen to be which Transcript shall be entred upon the Record of such County Court and the Justices of Such County Court shall by vertue of this Act award execution against the Defendant or Defendants by Capias ad Satisfaciendum ffieri facias or Attachment for the Debt or Damage with the Costs in the Judgment mencond together with such Additional Costs as shall be expended in such Court where such execution shall be awarded without suing out any writt of Scire facias.
