notwithstanding.

Provided also that no Ordinary Keeper within this province during the time of his Keeping Ordinary shall be Elected Chosen or Serve as a Deputy or Representative in the said Generall Assembly so to be hereafter called convened and appointed as aforesaid.

Be it enacted by the Queens most excellent Majesty by and p. 94 with the Advice and Consent of Matys Governour Councill and Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same that all Writts Pleas Process Indictments Informations Bills Suites Accons Judgments decrees and Sentences awarded of or Concerning any Matter or thing whatsoever which was sued or prosecuted to Judgment in any of the Courts of Record Chancery Admiralty or Comissarys Courts within this Province at any Time or Times since the first day of Aprill in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred and ninety to the tenth day of May One thousand six hundred ninety two And all Writts Pleas process Bills Suites Accons Indictments Informations Judgments Decrees and Sentences awarded of or concerning any Matter or thing whatsoever which was sued or prosecuted to Judgment in any of the Courts of Record Chancery Comissarys and Admiralty Courts within this Province at any time or Times from the death of his Excellency Lyonell Copley Esq late Governour of this Province to the Arrivall of
