

And it is further provided that if any fees for any Matter or thing hereafter to be done belonging to the Officers aforesaid by the Gov^r and Council so allowed and adjudged and not in this Act mencon'd Limited allowed and Adjudg'd it shall be lawfull for such Off^r To have such fee or fees as the said Governor & Council for the time being shall Adjudge and allow of & no more under the Penalty af^d to be recovered as aforesaid. This Act to endure for three Years or to the end of the next Sessions of Assembly which shall first happen after the three years

An Act for payment of fees due from Criminall Persons. p. 202

Be it Enacted by the Queens most excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of her Majestys Governour Council and Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same that from henceforth no Sheriff Goaler Clark Cryer or other Officer shall Charge either their own County to which they belong or the publiq with any fees for any Criminall Comitted to the Charge of the said Sheriff or Goaler having Sufficient Estate in this Province wherewith to pay the same or being Capable to pay the same by servitude but that such Criminalls being discharged by order and due Course of Law shall pay their Own fees to Sheriff Goaler Clark and Cryer and other Officers being such as they may demand according to Law either out of his Estate or by Servitude or otherwise.

Provided allways that this Act shall not extend to Malefactors that are Executed or to such other Psons who are banished having no Estate in this Province or to servants Criminalls for whom the County shall pay such fees as are due by the Acts of Assembly to the sheriff Goaler Clark Cryer or other Officers of such Court where such Criminall shall be Convicted.

And be it further enacted that all Officers fees due by Law from Criminall Servants shall be paid by the County where the ffact shall be Comitted and that all and every such Criminall servants for whom the County shall pay the fees due by Law
