Cap^t Jones and M^r Taylor Bring ffrom the house the following Message viz^t.

By the House of Dellegates May 25th 1705

Upon Reading the Report of the Conference yesterday the house proceeded to Debate the same.

1 As to Benj^a Celie this house are of Opinion that the said Celie being now in the Mercy of the Queen there is no need of An Act of Assembly to Transport him But leave him Intirely to the Disposal of his Ex^{ncy} the Gov^r to do with him as he thinks fitt

2 As to the Magazine Stores to be distributed (according to the former Proposall) and what is left to be at his Ex^{ncys} Disposall without the Charge of a Guard this house Readily Concurred therewith.

3 As to the Proposall Relating to the Rangers this house are willing they be still kept out and proposed that six men and an Officer be Ordered in Prince Georges County and the like in Baltemore County.

And this house humbly proposes to his Ex^{ncy} the Gov^r that the Cap^t of the Rangers in Prince Georges County be Removed and some other more fitt Person to be put instead to all which this house pray the Concurrence of his Ex^{ncys} & Councill
