The members upon your Invitation have intended with your Excellency to View the Church and have taken notice of the place you are pleased to be made for the Burgesses and Delegates to sitt in and we do very well approve of what your Ex<sup>cy</sup> has done and hold ourselves obliged to return you our hearty thanks for your regard of us and for the Care and Trouble you have been pleased to take in that affair and we desire you to order a small door to be cut over against the Porch by the Pulpit to give Air to the Church and when you see fit to add a small Vestry room to it, and that in laying out the Church Yard you will be pleased to enclose all the Graves within it
