Be it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Maj<sup>ty</sup> by and with the advice and consent of her Majesty's Governour Council and Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same that the Act of Assembly made at a generall Assembly begun and held at the Port of Annapolis the twenty Seventh day of June in the year of our Lord Sixteen hundred ninety nine Entituled An Act ascertainning the bounds of Land and every clause matter and thing therein contained is hereby declared to be and remaine in full force and effect to all intents constructions and purposes whatsoever to the end of the next Sessions of Assembly.
