Be it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Maj<sup>ty</sup> by & with the advice and Consent of her Maj<sup>ty</sup>s Governour Councill and Assembly of this province and the Authority of the same that the above menconed Act Ascertainning the height of ffences to prevent the Evill Occationed by the multitude of Horses and Restraineing horse Rangers within this province be and is hereby revived and Continued in full force and strength from and after this Present Session of Assembly for three yeares and to the end of the next Session of Assembly after the Three yeares. p. 380
