M^r John Gresham Sheriff of Ann Arundel County according to Order appeared at the Bar of this House and M^r Speaker acquainted him with the Order of the House relating to Edmondson as follows.

By the House of Delegates 31st October 1710.

Upon Complaint to this House that Thomas Edmondson a Servant to the Members of this House for Talbot County was arrested by the Sheriff of Ann Arundel County by Virtue of a Capias ad respondendum issued out of Ann Arundel County Court adss Thomas Macnemara in Breach of the Privilege of this House It's Ordered that the Sheriff immediately discharge the said Thomas Edmondson from the said Arrest or any other he now lies under without taking any Fees or Reward therefor whereof he is not to fail as he will answer the contrary to this House
