p. 405 An Act for Continueing the County Court of Queen Anns County at Queens Towne where the Court house now stands.

Whereas there is in Queen Anns County in this Province at Queens Town a good and suff' Court house well built made use of and found to be usefull and servicable to that County for holding the County Court of the said County and though perhaps some Doubts may arise whether the builders Connivers or Justices of the County had suff' authority for the building of the said Court house and for Raising and Levying tobacco on the Inhabitants of the said County for the defraying the Charge thereof.
